Site Review

The survey will begin by establishing the energy demand and key factors influencing your consumption. This will enable our engineer to carry out an informed review of your site during the visit. A site review can typically last from 1-10 days or more, depending on the complexity of the survey. It includes:

- Discussions about awareness and training with site personnel
- On-site evaluation of your equipment and operations

Survey Output

Output comprises a written report describing the findings, opportunities for improvement and estimated savings, so you can make informed decisions based on expected payback. A typical report will cover:

- An analysis of your energy use, where appropriate compared to similar organisations
- A review of the strengths and weaknesses of your current energy management procedures
- A list of energy saving opportunities including new technologies that should be implemented, estimated costs, savings and payback period

Follow Up

The report must initiate action as a result of the findings. To encourage this, we will ensure that you receive a follow up visit by your consultant to discuss the findings and help plan strategies for implementing the improvements. 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Case Study

A leading professional services firm was seeking an experienced consultancy to establish ways of quickly reducing their energy consumption. Our task was to review the energy demand of the current operational model and make new and practical suggestions for improvement, taking into account operational constraints.

Phase One

Before the site visit, we worked with the customer to agree objectives and output expectations and to develop an effective approach. The first phase involved modelling the specific energy consumption across eight sites to establish a league table of best and worst performing sites.

Phase Two

Site surveys were carried out at a representative number of best and worst performing sites to evaluate areas such as; technology used, monitoring and control of energy, purchasing policy, levels of staff awareness.

Review Meeting

Review meetings were held at intermediate points throughout the survey programme to provide the opportunity to share initial findings and receive feedback on the approach and content of survey output.

Results

The survey identified savings in excess of £350,000 per annum and a forum for recording and sharing best practice was recommended.
